

Peter Rothstein - Short Biography

Peter Rothstein works extensively as a director of theater, musical theater, opera and new work development. He is the Founding Artistic Director of Theater Latté Da, a Twin Cities-based company dedicated to adventurous musical theater. Other directing credits include the Guthrie, Children's Theatre Company, Minnesota Opera, Ten Thousand Things and Seattle's 5th Avenue Theater. He is the creator of *All Is Calm: The Christmas Truce of 1914* and *Steerage Song*, created in collaboration with Dan Chouinard. He has been awarded five Ivey Awards for overall excellence and has received fellowships from the National Endowment for the Arts, Theatre Communications Group, the Minnesota State Arts Board and the McKnight Foundation. He serves on the board of directors for the National Alliance for Musical Theatre.
